-crayons/markers -construction paper

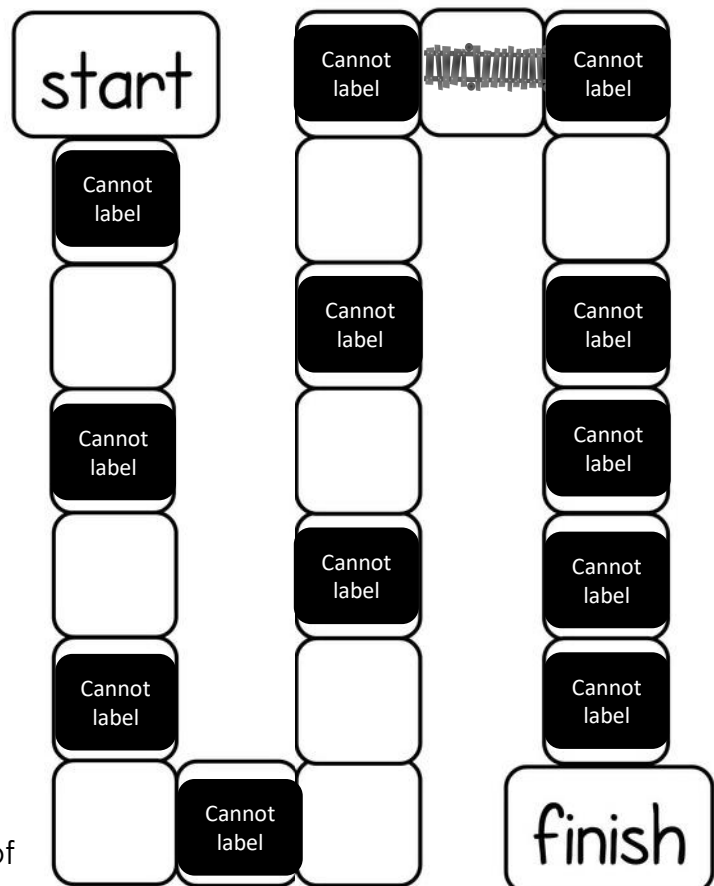


★ **Game Board:**
